

INFORMATION / CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS.

JUNIOR MEMBERS PLAY AT THEIR OWN RISK
It is not the responsibility of the Club to supervise junior members.

ALWAYS REMEMBER

YOU HAVE JOINED A TENNIS CLUB. BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER BLADES, FOOTBALLS ETC. MUST NEVER BE BROUGHT INSIDE THE CLUB GATE.

EVIDENCE OF MEMBERSHIP The shoe tag must be worn or at least clearly recognisable I.D. must be available as proof of your membership. If not you will be asked to leave.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP Is for you alone. You are not allowed to bring non-member friends into the club. Parents and other family members are not allowed to use the courts with you unless they themselves are fully paid up club members.

CLUBHOUSE The Clubhouse is for the use of Senior Members only.

PADLOCKS The padlock code will be given to you on receipt of your membership fee and is not to be given to anyone else.

DRESS Wear sensible sports clothes, preferably white shirt, shorts or skirt, NOT BEACH WEAR. To protect the court surface from damage you must wear proper tennis shoes, which can be checked by any member. Shoes or trainers with heels or hard-ridged soles damage the surface of the court.

NETS The nets are kept at the proper height so leave them alone.

FENCING Do not damage the perimeter surrounds by using them as rebound walls.

CHEWING GUM is absolutely forbidden – discarded chewing gum ruins the playing surfaces.

TENNIS BALLS You will find cans of tennis balls for your use in the changing rooms.

LITTER Always put your litter in the bin by the changing rooms or take it home.

PLAYING TIMES You may play any time other than Club afternoons. Senior Members have priority over the use of the carpet courts.

COACHING Coaching sessions are arranged during the summer term. Further details will be posted on the notice board.
Attending coaching lessons on their own does not make you a club member.

CLUB ETIQUETTE Keep noise down to minimum – noisy players may be asked to leave.

SECURITY It is most important that the last person to leave the Club locks all the doors and gates securely. Bring some means of contacting a responsible adult with you in the event of injury.

You have joined the Club to play and enjoy tennis. For yours and others safety, horseplay and other unacceptable behaviour cannot be allowed. You will always be welcome as a member providing you follow the above code and behave sensibly.
